AccelR8 - Creating Pathways to Employment Information for Schools, Parents and Students

What is AccelR8?

AccelR8 is a Department of Education and Training (DET) 'school to work' transition program which prepares students in all aspects of employment, whilst they are still at school. It includes a 20 week (1 day per week) Structured Workplace Learning program and completion of Certificate II in Automotive Vocational Preparation. The AccelR8 program can be tailored to suit students with an interest in light vehicle mechanics or the heavy commercial vehicle sector.

AccelR8 is a partnership between the following stakeholders:

- Employers who provide the work placement experience and future employment opportunities for participants
- Registered training organisations (RTO) which provide the training and assessment services required for the delivery of the industry endorsed and nationally accredited qualification
- Secondary schools which supply and support the students undertaking the program
- School students who participate and commit to completion of the program whilst at school
- Parents/guardians who support the students to participate and complete the program



 DET which provides funding for the provision of the qualification through the VET In Schools (VETiS) program and regional officers who facilitate and co-ordinate the program
