

SHAILER PARK STATE HIGH SCHOOL 2019 STUDENT RESOURCES SCHEME (SRS) YEARS 7 TO 12

There are three components of the Student Resources Scheme (SRS). These components are:-

- 1. What parents and carers are required to provide
- 2. What the School provides when the Parent / Carer accept to pay the Student Resource Scheme Parent Contribution fee
- 3. What the school provides when your child undertakes an elective subject that has an applicable subject fee.

STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME charge for this year is a base fee of \$320.00 (this includes the ICT Levy of \$50.00).

If you commence the school payment plan or Centrepay Plan at the beginning of the year, this amount works out to \$8.00 per week.

WHAT THE SCHEME PROVIDES

By paying the participation fee your child will receive a range of materials including:

- Student Homework Diary / Planner
- Student ID Card
- All Textbooks for in-class use
- Reproduced class workbooks & worksheets
- Class Novels
- 1GB Internet Access Per Month Per Student
- Student reference materials (e.g. books, audio / video tapes, software access)
- Class Consumables E.g. Items for Science Experiments, Paints for Art Projects
- Sporting Equipment
- Printer Toner

WHAT THE SCHEME DOES NOT PROVIDE

The scheme does not provide:

- The consumables / stationery required by students
- An additional fee for students choosing to participate in one of our Additional programs (see attached)
- The up-front fee for Certificate courses offered in the senior school which must be paid up-front for essential resources and fees required to deliver these offerings

Please refer to the "Consumables to be provided by Parent / Carer" on the stationery information list requirements for each specific subject. Please note that these "consumable" are required on the first day of classes.

EXCURSIONS, EXTRA-CURRICULA AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY COSTS

Excursions, extra-curricular and recreational activities are **NOT** covered by the SRS and are based on a user pays system. The Principal has the right to exclude a student from these activities due to non-payment of Scheme Fees.

- Return above form along with your student costing information sheet for Additional Programs
- An initial payment per nominated student <u>MUST</u> be made the first week of each school year
- All fees are to be paid by 29th March, 2019
